SUBJECT : CANCELLATION OF A PAPER WEIGHT SLIP

THAI Cargo has been providing outbound weighting services through a computer system (CHORUS), which normally prints out weight slips in a paper form, and sends e-weight slips as a PDF file to export representatives' emails registered in our database.

During systematic testing, the result has been very efficient and effective to our work process. THAI Cargo now intends to facilitate and reduce our service processing time with faster cargo scale weighting and AWB's submission. Thereby, we will officially cancel the use of paper weighting slips and remain only e-weight slips sent via emails registered in our database.

In this new process, when customers finish weighting, they can submit AWB to Outbound Documentation Division (FO) without having to attach copied weight slip with AWB.

Furthermore, if any export representatives would like to change the details on submitted weight slip, they would have to contact Weight Slip functions for information correction before AWB is submitted to Outbound Documentation Division (FO).

Thai Cargo would like to request all export representatives to check the detail of email registration on the E-Weight Slip with Weight Slip functions before the project is launched.

This will be effective from 16 March 2020 onwards.
